






Q3. The course integrates theoretical course concepts with real-world applications


Q4. The assignments and internal evaluation covered the materials presented in the course



STUDENT STRONGLY AGREE ON COURSE - 2015-16


Feedback on course has been collected from 1014 students across different program during academic year 2015-16



Observation:

The feedback has highlighted that, 88% of students says that the assignments and exams covered the materials presented in the course, and 12% students felt the assignments are connecting to the syllabus. 90% students said that the syllabus clearly states course objectives, requirements, procedures and grading criteria however 10% students says grading criteria and the procedures are not clear.83% responses accepted that the course material is up to date, where as 17% responses expressed that the course materials is not upto date, and not relevant for industry requirements.

Feedback on teacher has been collected from 1014 students across different programs during the year. The summary analysis is presented below




Observation:

Out of 1121 Feedback forms only 1014 were found to be perfect for analysis. Feedback on teachers is analyzed and presented using bar diagram. From the graph, it is clearly perceived that teacher's efficiency in teaching and managing course content is in the proper manner. Most of the teacher's performance is up to the standard expectations of students and rated well in the feedback.95% students happy about the teachers regularity, punctuality and ability to bring clarity in the concepts of course curriculum.

Aggregate feedback analysis of employer feedback collected from 39 employers has been presented for the academic year 2015-16




Observation:

More than 90% employers are happy about the reliability and honesty of the employees and thery are happy with the overall performance of the employees. Only 77% feel that the syllabus is research oriented and suggest to improve research culture, startup culture among students through proper framework of syllabus.

Teachers Strongly agree on curriculum for the academic year - 2015-16

Feedback on curriculum was collected from 79 teachers for the academic year 2015-16. The analysis is presented with the responses who strongly agree on different parameters of curriculum aspects.




Observation:

Only 75% teachers expressed that they are given freedom to contribute to course development at the university. 83% teachers feel the course content give weightage to employability skills of students, and 17% teachers feel the syllabus should be upgraded to meet the needs of industry requirements. 82% teachers feel BOS is taking care of relevance of programs and course offered are relevant to the present situation.

Alumni Strongly agree on curriculum for the academic year - 2015-16

Alumni feedback on curriculum is gathered from 483 alumni of different batches, a summary of their response who have strongly agreed on curricular aspects for the academic year 2015-16 is presented.




Observation:

93% alumni strongly feel the environment in the instuition is excellent for learning. 85% feel that the course content has relevance and updated. Only 80% feel the program and course is capable for catering to the job requirements. Alumni also express that the courses should intellectually stimulate them for research and further studies.

Parents Strongly agree about the institution – 2015-16


Feedback from Parents about the institution has been collected from 339 parents during the year 2015-16, and its analysis is presented below



Observation:

More than 90% parents are happy about the academic discipline, examination system adopted by the institution and improvement of soft skills and knowledge of their wards, 89% parents strongly feel the admission procedure is good and fair. 81% parents feel the use of ICT usage in the institution is excellent and there is a need for improvement of library, sports and cultural activities.

Student response has been collected and analyzed using excel spread sheet. Student feedback on faculty has been complied department wise and the response is shown on the graph. More than 85% responses shows satisfaction in the performance of the Science, Commerce, Management, Humanities, Languages and English.

- 5) Bring necessary changes through introduction of value added/ add on courses to include updated knowledge in the teachers & learning environment.
- Library holding should be enhanced in Research section, subscription to ejournals, database should be adopted for encouraging students for research contribution.
