

Some kids are suffering from speech and sound disorder (SSD); those kids are unable to pronounce the words properly for example they cannot pronounce 'r' but they are using 'l' instead of 'r'. Few kids, later come out with this problem after certain duration but some of them carry the problem throughout their entire life. This can be treated with proper guidance in early detection. If we left this disorder left untreated, it will affect the child in his all activities like learning ability, write and reading skills.

Phonological dis order is one in which children are not possible to produce the words properly they are creating different sound because they are creating word in wrong part of their mouth which mean they are pronouncing in back part of their mouth. These communication disorders need to be identified at the beginning stage help them to solve their problem as well as it will them to build the strategy for better communication disorder. The family people play a dominant role to solve this kind of issues because the family people also required to work to resolve this kind communication issues among children's along with the therapist.

Generally, the communication disorders are identified in the home or before joining to the school itself but it is rare case where we can identify some minor communication disorders in the school level also. As per the individual Disability Education Act each and every student with disability also have rights to get equal education like a normal child, schools also facilitating to these children to develop individual Education program.

Articulation is one condition in this state of phonetic level due to the deficiency in the vocal organs. Here we can see some of the symptoms of articulations are distortion of sound, substitution omission and additional sounds. For example, child may tell dough instead of dog.

Language disorder causes because of lack of vocabulary, in this condition child or adult struggle to understand hence it is not possible to construct meaning full phrases or to understand the meaning full statements it is mainly because of hearing loss or any other kind of mental issues.

Hearing loss is the major problem which cause the communication disorder because it will build a gap between the normal person with dough person. With the help of audiologist and electronic hearing aids support will eradicate this problem and build a confidence among the people who


