

They were also taught how importance our environment is, through the sign language as some of the students were deaf and dump. Their response was very positive. School children sang and danced for filmy music, it was a very memorable cherishing moments, unforgettable and respect for the faculties handling those challenged children who are future of India coming from distance villages of Kaiwara. 

The Maitreya Buddha Pyramid inside the Pyramid Valley occupies a base area of 160' x160' and is as tall as a ten-storey building at a 102 ft. height. It can accommodate about 5,000 meditators at a time.

The Pyramid is constructed on the principles of the Great Pyramid of Giza. Oriented exactly in the North – South direction, the four faces of the Pyramid have the golden angle of inclination at 51°50′. The King's Chamber is located at the centre of the Pyramid, at 1/3rd the height from the base of the Pyramid. According to the Masters there, King's Chamberabsorbs a lot of cosmic energy from the cosmos.

Thousands of people meditate daily inside the Pyramid and hence there is stupendous energy available for everyone to get recharged.



We also got to see the beautiful carvings of Lord Buddha on the walls of the Pyramid and also took the blessings of the lord. The Spiritual books related to meditation were kept for references and to purchasenotonly that many meterials were there for purchase.

Report on World Forest Day - 2022

International Day of Forests is observed every year on March 21 since 2012. The day aims to raise awareness regarding the importance of all types of forests. The International Day of Forests was established in 2012 by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO). All countries are encouraged to undertake local, national and international activities involving forests and trees, such as tree-planting campaigns to commemorate World Forestry Day. The International Day of Forests 2022 theme is "Forests and sustainable production and consumption". The theme for each World Forest Day is chosen by the Collaborative Partnership on Forests (CPF).

The main objective of the programme was to raise awareness of the importance of all types of forests, promoting synergies between climate change mitigation and adaptation across landscapes. More than 300 participants involved in "Insight Sustainable Trees Production and Consumption" MSRCASC, CAMPUS, Bengaluru.

Environmental Committee organized World Forest Day as an extension activity 10:30 am to 12:30 pm involving students, teaching and non teaching staffs in sighting the herbs, shrubs and trees in and around M.S. Ramaiah College of Arts, Science and Commerce campus. Prof. Jayashree DR, Resource person, Department of Biotechnology and Genetics, MSRCASC, Bengaluru, explained practically the importance of herbs, shrubs and trees. MSRCASC surrounds more than 100 medicinal plants, some of them were timber yielding, some trees yields biofuels and other were ornamental but economically important. Most of them were colourful shrubs yielding beautiful flowers, which attract butterflies and bees, natural pollinators. Many birds and rodents, snakes lizards, beetles, are also found in the campus garden. Approximate Environment audit survey reports 125 herbs, 86 trees and 62 shrubs. Dry leaves and twigs are decomposed in the garden making use of microorganisms from Microbiology and Biotechnology laboratories as a naturalorganic fertilizers reused for the garden areas. Also, vermicompost pits are maintained. Madam also, explained how Michelia champak dried flowers petals are collected by the vendors to reuse for scenting the agarbhatis. The program ended with distribution of ice-cream to all the participants as it was too sunny, moving around the campus. Students noted done the Florae names and its economic importance.
