Report on FDP on Preparation for UGC - NET: Paper 1

The Department of Commerce had organized an FDP on Preparation for UGC-NET: Paper 1 from 21.02.2022 to 03.03.2022 for the faculties and PG students. The resource person for the session was Mr. Chetan.

Objectives

The main objective of this session was to enable the participants to crack UGC-NET exams. The session provided different techniques to solve the problems with less time. The session discussed about the concepts in UGC NET paper 1. It also focused on enhancing the professional knowledge, reasoning ability and arithmetic intellectuality. Logical understanding and applicability in right manner is also one of major outcomes of the session.

The techniques used in the sessions made the quantitative aptitude easier and faster to solve. These techniques are important to solve it quickly as time taken is important during the examinations. The calculation of multiplication, division and decimals were made simple through the session.

The session further discussed about the clocks, time taken. Formulas also were used wherever required. The concepts on calendar were also discussed during the session. The differences between the leap year and ordinary year, the usage of odd days and their applicability to find the past or future dates were discussed. Coding

and decoding was also a part of the session. The different techniques used in coding

was discussed.

The session educated about the concept of number series, different techniques used

to find the missing value was explained in detail. Apart from these, the different

ways to find out the missing values were also discussed. Blood relations was also

one of the very significant topics that was discussed. Understanding the relations,

their generations was discussed. This concept was made easy to understand by the

usage if different techniques.

Determination of percentages with fractions and decimals were discussed. The

calculation of different problems on profit and loss was done. In Ratios and

proportions, the faster method to find ratios were explained.

The concepts of time, distance and speed was taught using different formulas. The

logics used to easily calculate time, speed and distance was discussed. The

appropriate way to analyze syllogism was explained during the session. The

statements and the way to analyze the solution was discussed. Analogy and Venn

diagram was also briefed. The basic relations with different elements were

discussed and usage of the Venn diagram was also used.

OUTCOME

The sessions enhanced the knowledge level amongst the participants about UGC-Net

paper 1. High difficulty level problems were taught with simple and quick problem-


solving methods. The sessions enabled the participants to understand the simple

techniques used for solving the problems.




