Objective of the FDP

Understanding the value of activity-based practical learning through the simple facilitation of faculty on how to bridge the gap in the students' industrial expectations.

Department of Commerce organized one day faculty development programme on Emotional Intelligence on 20th october 2022. The chief guest of the inaugural session was Dr Vatsala. G, Principal, RCASC and Prof BS Jayarama, Vice principal, HOD, Department of Commerce, RCASC. The institution's efforts were praised, and Mr. Ramani Venkat, an NLP resource person, thanked the team on holding the FDP successfully. He stated that the FDP supports faculty in being coached to improve their teaching, administrative, and research skills. The Chief Guest also underlined the value of inter-professional collaboration, wherein teams of academic members from many fields work together and communicate, thereby enhancing students' learning during these trying times.

The morning session began at 10:00 AM with the goal of introducing faculties to the concept of emotional intelligence. Ms. Krithi V.P., Assistant Professor, gave the opening address before the resource person continued it. The session began with a definition of emotional intelligence and participant orientation in order to make controlling emotions, or the following stage, easier. The participants were led through the process of comprehending the distinctions between emotions, thinking, and behaviour using active learning techniques. The resource person talked about how to develop leadership skills in faculty members and stude and also gave an insight on how to understand and control emotions. The resource person engaged in activities involving risk and stress management during the entire session.

The second session started at 2.00 PM focussing on Four key elements of emotional intelligence i.e., self awareness, self management, social awareness, and social management. Self awareness which involves recognizing the fundamental feelings and being able to distinguish between main, secondary, and emotional effects. The participants were aware of the four essential factors and later went through a few tools to determine one's own emotional intelligence levels and also Blooms taxonomy for higher order learning (L3 to L6) helped faculties to integrate emotional intelligence into daily thinking.

Outcome of the FDP

The programme will assist the participants in developing a fundamental grasp of emotional intelligence and in knowing how to apply emotional intelligence in a variety of contexts and also helped the faculties to understand the difference between IQ and EQ.
