Unlike job-related skills (e.g., used a cash register), these skills can be applied in every occupation. Below is a list of transferable skills. COMMON INTERVIEW QUESTIONS: The following are sample questions that are typically asked of interviewees. Some questions are designed to get specific details while other questions are designed to get a feel for your personality and character. It is a great idea to decide how you would answer these questions beforehand.

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Questions You Can Ask During the Interview: At the end of a job interview, the interviewer may ask, "Do you have any questions?" The interviewer will expect you to have intelligent, well-thought-out questions that indicate you have some knowledge of the job for which you are applying. Also, it reveals how well you listened to the interviewer. Do your research and ask appropriate questions? Here are some examples. Would you describe the duties I would be performing? What would be the time frame for filling this position? If hired, who will be my supervisor? How would I be trained or introduced to the job? With whom would I be working with and what are their duties? How would my performance be evaluated? Who would evaluate me and when? Can someone in this position be promoted? If so, to what position? Of your most successful employees, what characteristics do they possess that helped them to be successful? What is the customer service philosophy of your company? What is the best part about working here?


The exam consists of 40-60 multiple-choice questions and will have 60 minutes to complete it.
