




#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**






#### **Observation:**






#### **Observation:**

## 4. Course content develops the right skill set to perform on job






#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**






#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**

## 2. Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development.




















































#### **Observation:**




#### **Observation:**





#### **IQAC RECOMMENDATIONS**

The IQAC submitted the feedback analysis report to the management through the Academic Council. The report made a special reference to considering teachers' performance and motivating them with appropriate encouragement.

Following are some of the recommendations made:

- The course content in the curriculum should be revised periodically, ensuring a good balance between theory and practical components. Additionally, care should be taken to develop a curriculum that intellectually stimulates all students.
- Teaching faculty should undergo periodic training to update their knowledge, which can then be applied in their teaching.
- A competent curriculum should be designed to meet current educational needs, keeping students prepared for present-day demands, both personal and professional.
- Creating an interface between industry and academia will enhance the curriculum by improving course outcomes.
- In line with suggestions, a practical approach beyond traditional classroom teaching should be emphasized, promoting a research-oriented mindset.
- Soft skills training should be provided to students to enhance their competence and career prospects.
