




The Department of Biotechnology and Genetics at MSRCASC convened a Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) on the 19th of November, 2024, at the Abdul Kalam Auditorium. The lecture was delivered by Mrs. Bhargavi S. Rao, an esteemed independent researcher, educator, and trustee at the Environment Support Group (ESG).

Dr. Panchami, an Assistant Professor within the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry, initiated the program with the rendition of the Ramaiah anthem, subsequently progressing to deliver a welcome address. Prof. Jayarama, the Vice Principal, graciously welcomed the speaker by presenting her with a sapling.

Dr. Vijayalakshmi from the Department of Biotechnology and Genetics formally introduced the speaker, Mrs. Bhargavi.

In her presentation, Mrs. Bhargavi elucidated the fundamental concepts of IPR and underscored the pressing issue of biopiracy, which pertains to the unauthorized exploitation of biological resources or traditional knowledge without equitable benefit-sharing. Through illustrative examples such as neem, basmati rice, and turmeric, she articulated the challenges India has encountered regarding biopiracy perpetrated by foreign entities. Additionally, she examined the implications of genetically modified crops, specifically Bt. cotton and Bt. brinjal, placing significant emphasis on the ethical considerations, biodiversity impacts, and patenting issues they engender.

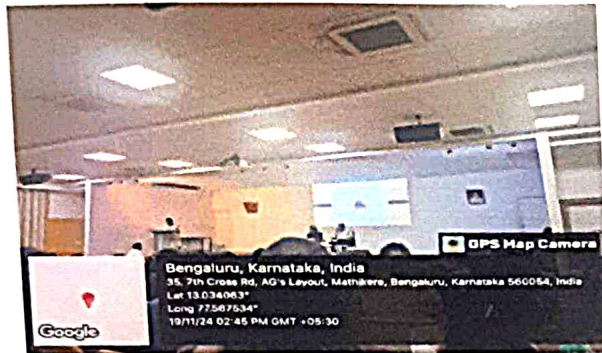
Mrs. Bhargavi emphasized the imperative for the establishment of more robust legal frameworks, the adherence to ethical standards, and the promotion of sustainable development as a means to

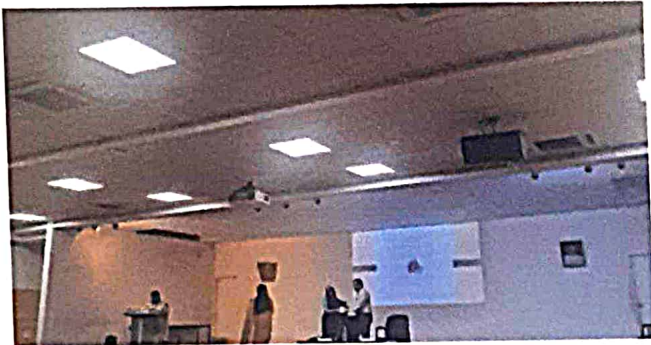

2. How effective was the session in increasing your understanding of biopiracy and its relevance to IPR?

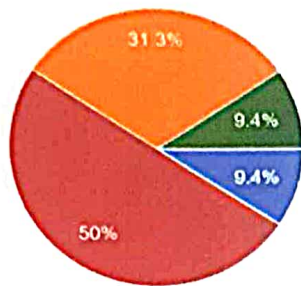

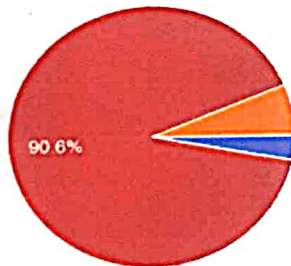


3. Did the FDP meet your expectations in terms of content and delivery?

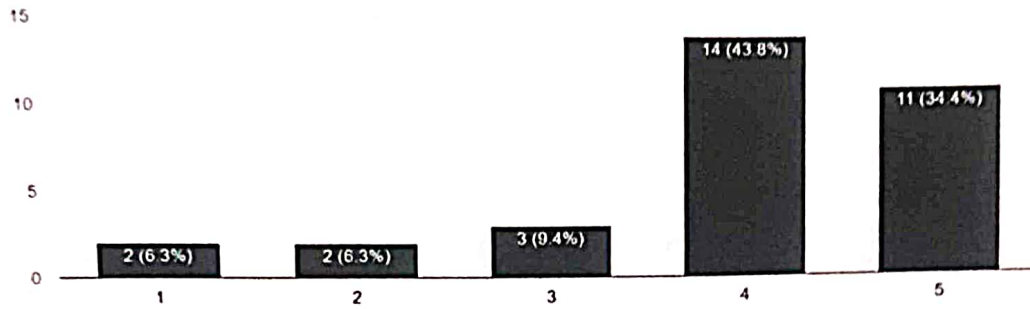

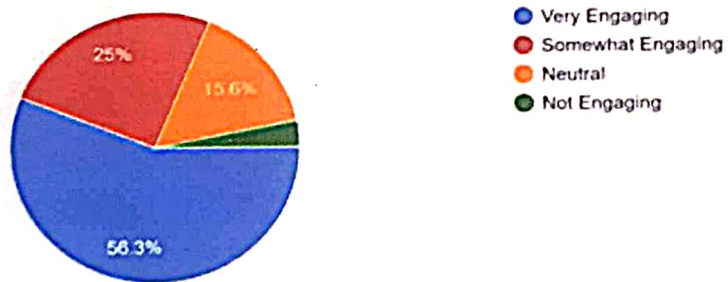

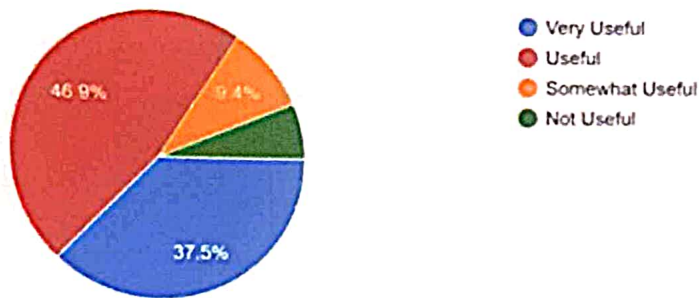
