#### **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**



As a registered trust, the Gokula Education Foundation operates several educational institutions under the flagship of GEF, including the M.S. Ramaiah College of Arts, Science, and Commerce (MSRCASC), which was established in 1994. Permanently affiliated with Bengaluru City University (BCU), MSRCASC gained autonomous status in 2023–24, recognized by the UGC, the Government of Karnataka, and BCU. The college is acknowledged by the UGC under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956, and in 2021, it achieved an "A" grade in its fourth cycle of NAAC reaccreditation.


MSRCASC's MBA and MCA programs are approved by AICTE, New Delhi, and recognized by the Government of Karnataka. The institution earned a rank in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2024, ranked 87th in the college category, affirming its position as one of Karnataka's leading colleges. In 2022, it was selected by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, under the DBT-STAR College Scheme. The Department of Biotechnology at MSRCASC is also designated as a research center by BCU, and the college is in the process of gaining recognition as an Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) Centre.

The institution has a unique learning platform offering multidisciplinary programs that play a pioneering role in providing academic excellence. The institution offers eight undergraduate programs and seven postgraduate programs in the streams of arts, science, commerce, and management with 2904 students. With the adoption of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, MSRCASC now provides 15 undergraduate honors programs and has an established research center in Biotechnology. 




# "Raise a Glass to Innovation: Wine Making Workshop on Crafting Business Success!"

#### "Cyber Skills for the Future: Interactive Workshop for BCA Fresher's!"










# "Unleashing Creativity: A Journey into the Art of Storytelling"
