REPORT ON FDP - RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT-2005

This program aims to enhance the knowledge and understanding of faculty members regarding the provisions, significance, and implementation of the Right to Information (RTI) Act.

Objectives:

- a) To familiarize faculty members with the key provisions and objectives of the RTI Act.
- b) To enhance the understanding of faculty members about the importance and implications of the right to information in a democratic society.
- c) To equip faculty members with the necessary skills to effectively access and utilize information under the RTI Act.

Department Of Commerce in association with IQAC organised one day Faculty Development Program on 'The Issues & Challenges of Right to Information Act 2005. The Session started with the Ramaiah Anthem. Ms. Sunitha Gurukar, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce introduced the Resource Person. Ms. Sindhu M, Assistant Professor welcomed the audience and the Resource Person. followed by Principal Dr. Vatsala G, delivered the presidential address. The program covered the following key topics:

- b) Provisions of the RTI Act: Detailed analysis of the provisions, exemptions, and limitations of the Act.
- c) Accessing Information: Exploring the procedures and mechanisms for accessing information under the RTI Act.
- d) Role of Faculty in Promoting Right to Information: Discussing the responsibilities and opportunities for faculty members in advocating and utilizing the right to information.
- e) Case Studies and Best Practices: Examining real-life case studies and examples of successful implementation of the RTI Act.
- f) Interactive Sessions: The resource person provided opportunity for all the participants to clarify their doubts on Rights To Information Act 2005.
