**Objective:**


- ❖ To educate and empower individuals about the prevention, early detection, and treatment of breast, cervical, and lung cancer.

- ❖ This activity will help students to actively engage in learning, problem-solving, and advocacy on important social, environmental, and health-related issues.

**World Cancer Day** is observed every year on **February 4<sup>th</sup>** to raise awareness about cancer and encourage prevention, detection, and treatment. Established by the **Union for International Cancer Control (UICC)** in 2000, the day aims to unite individuals, organizations, and governments to combat the global cancer burden. By spreading awareness and advocating for better policies, **World Cancer Day** plays a crucial role in the global fight against cancer, emphasizing that **"Together, we can make a difference."**

Department of Microbiology, M S Ramaiah College of Arts, Science and Commerce-Autonomous, Bangalore in association with NSS and Microbiologists Society, India organized February 4<sup>th</sup> 2025. Students of BSc and MSc actively participated in the event and created awareness about Lung Cancer, Cervical Cancer, Breast Cancer and general cancer awareness.

The activity was divided into two sessions **Classroom Awareness Sessions and Shop-to-Shop Awareness Drive**

For **first session** all the students were divided into groups.





- The students visited various classrooms within the institution.
- They conducted short presentations on cancer types, causes, symptoms, and preventive measures.
- Educational pamphlets and posters were displayed to enhance understanding.

For **second session** was road show by the students where students along with faculty members **Mrs. Soumya S Shanbhag, Dr. Tejaswini H K, and Dr. Nimitha Venugopal C**, did road show and visited different shops nearby the college and created the awareness among common people.

- Students divided into small teams and visited local shops and businesses.
- Shopkeepers and customers were briefed about cancer prevention strategies.
- Informative leaflets were displayed and posters were displayed in key locations.
- Emphasis was placed on lifestyle modifications, such as avoiding tobacco and maintaining a healthy diet.

#### **Outcome:**

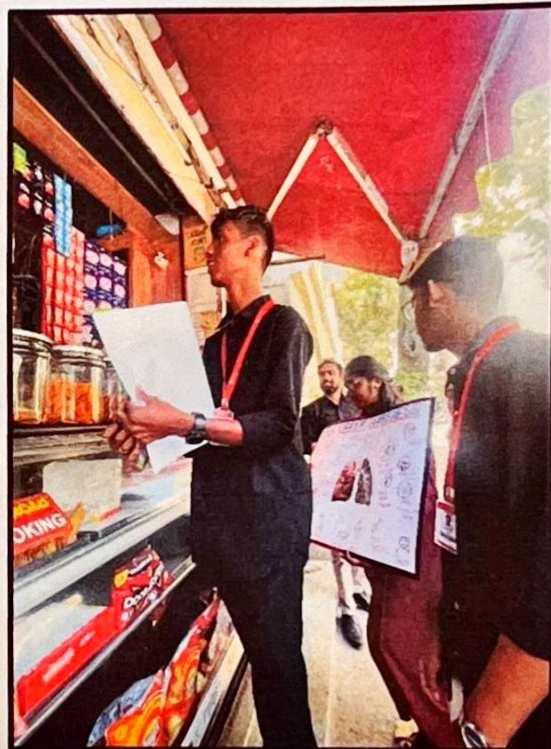
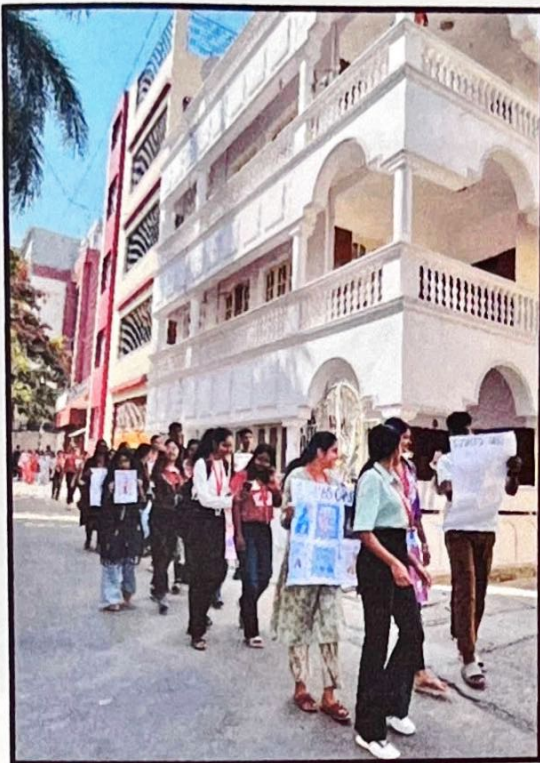
- ❖ To encourage students to actively engage in learning, problem-solving, and advocacy on important social, environmental, and health-related issues.

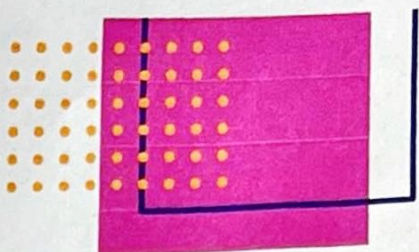
