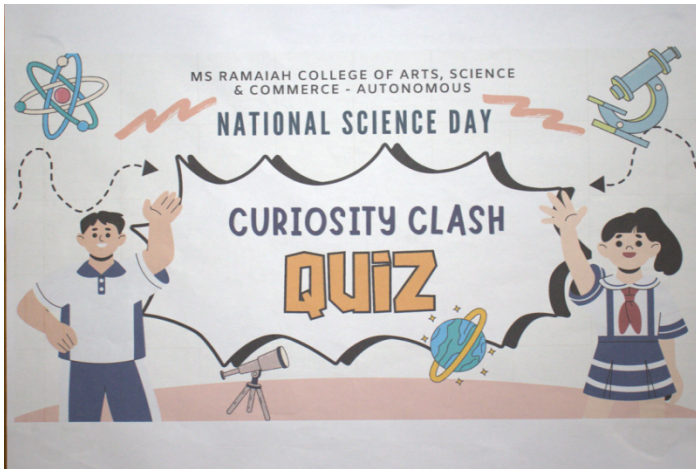

The department of BSc computer science in collaboration with NSS organised an outreach

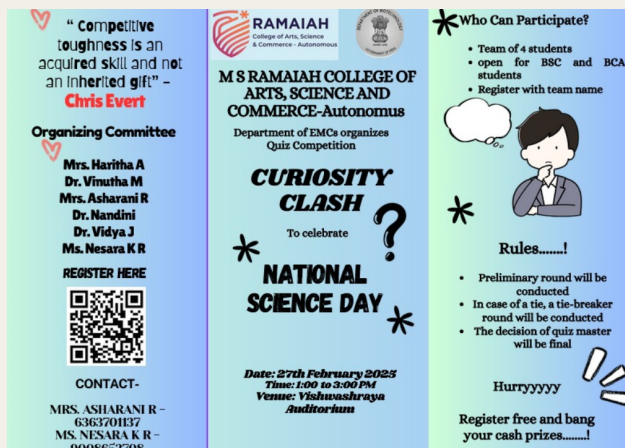
